

10 SCRIPTURE CONFESSIONS FOR DADS

1. I Lead with Wisdom

I have the mind of Christ and the wisdom of God. I lead my family with clarity, strength, and peace.

2. I Am a Steady Example

I walk with integrity before the Lord, and my children are blessed because of it.

4. My Children Are Protected

No weapon formed against my children will prosper. They are protected by God's hand and surrounded by peace.

5. God Provides for My Family
